

Internship Opportunities at The Digital Stone Project



The Digital Stone Project, a non-profit artist-run stone sculpture fabrication facility in Mercerville, NJ is accepting inquiries for internships. These positions, which will be organized with the student's needs and skill levels in mind, will be made available to a select group of students each semester. Internships might consist of work in the stone shop, the office (arts administration or 3D digital design) or assisting instructors teaching stone carving classes. Interns might work in all or some of these areas. Interns are expected to work 1 or 2 days per week.

Interns will be provided with school credit (when available through their school), work experience, digital sculpture skills, a personal work space in the shop, access to tools, time to work on personal work and a pre-determined amount of stone for personal sculpture.

There are only a few internships available each semester. Interested students should write a letter of inquiry, specifying the area of their interest (stone work, digital 3D design, non-profit arts administration, teaching, etc.), their experience levels and what skills they would like to learn/improve during the internship, their availability (days, times, length of the internship), school contact information (for school credit arrangements) and any other information they deem appropriate. Tell us what you hope to achieve through the experience and what you can offer to us. Stone carving skills are not required to be selected for an internship. We are seeking intelligent, creative, hardworking and reliable interns.
